The Curriculum is Play Based and the children also integrate with the whole school community for occasions such as plays, assemblies and special events. The pupils wear their own uniform and are fully prepared for their entry into Primary One – It's a wonderful opportunity to begin their educational journey! ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY REMINDERS

If your child is absent for any reason please email the school on <u>info@jonesmemorial.enniskillen.ni.sch.uk</u> giving a reason for non-attendance on the first day of absence, please follow this up with a brief email on their return.

This is for the Education Welfare Service. Thank you to those who already do so. We understand this year is particularly challenging for our families in maintaining excellent attendance, however we use a particular code on the register for children absent because of COVID meaning we can take this into consideration when monitoring attendance. The Minister of Education has made clear, that children absent due to COVID will not be flagged up as non-attenders.

Lateness is also monitored by the Education Welfare Officer so please endeavour to have your child into school by their allocated staggered time.

Mrs Doonan and I continue to monitor the attendance of all children each month and will write to parents where attendance is a concern.

In JMPS our School Council has defined Bullying as...

"Bullying is behaviour which is done on purpose and happens over and over. It can make people feel hurt and upset. It can be verbal, social, physical, emotional or aggressive behaviour which is caused repeatedly by a person or a group of people. It can mean that someone is picked on or made fun of almost every day and they cannot stop it happening. Not all nasty behaviour is bullying behaviour. Some bad behaviour may have been done only once or by an accident, but bullying is planned and keeps happening."

Anti-Bullying week is (Monday 15th – Friday 19th November). This year's theme as set by the Northern Ireland Anti-Bullying Forum is "One Kind Word".

Pupils will take part in a range of lessons throughout the week and discuss various types of bullying and what is the difference between bullying and unacceptable behaviour.

Buttercup Club


