Daily Snack includes: A small piece of fruit and a bread-based snack (eg, pancake, toast, bagel etc) or a Friday treat (chocolate crispie bun etc) delivered to your child's class.

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE UPDATE

As per the information on a previous newsletter, we will now be using updated Department of Education guidelines when monitoring school attendance using a new TIER system.

The different tiers are outlined below:

TIER 1a Pupils recognised as 'Regular Attendance' missing 0% - 0.49% of school. Roughly less than 1 day per month.

TIER 1b Pupils recognised as 'At Risk Attendance' missing 5% - 9.9% of school. Roughly 1+ day per month.

TIER 2 Pupils recognised as 'Chronic Attendance' missing 10% - 19.9% of school. Roughly 2-3 days per month.

TIER 3 Pupils recognised as 'Severe Chronic Attendance' missing 20% or more of school.

Please ensure that you contact the school office in the morning if your child is not able to attend school. Attendance updates will be issued to parents/guardians for the month of September in due course as we continue to monitor attendance and offer support where needed.
